Organize and lead training for employees on their roles within the BCP, ensuring organization-wide understanding and engagement. Develop training materials and awareness content to reinforce business continuity knowledge and practices. Promote a culture of preparedness through continuous learning and internal knowledge-sharing mechanisms. Analyze test outcomes and disruption responses to identify areas for improvement and implement corrective actions.
